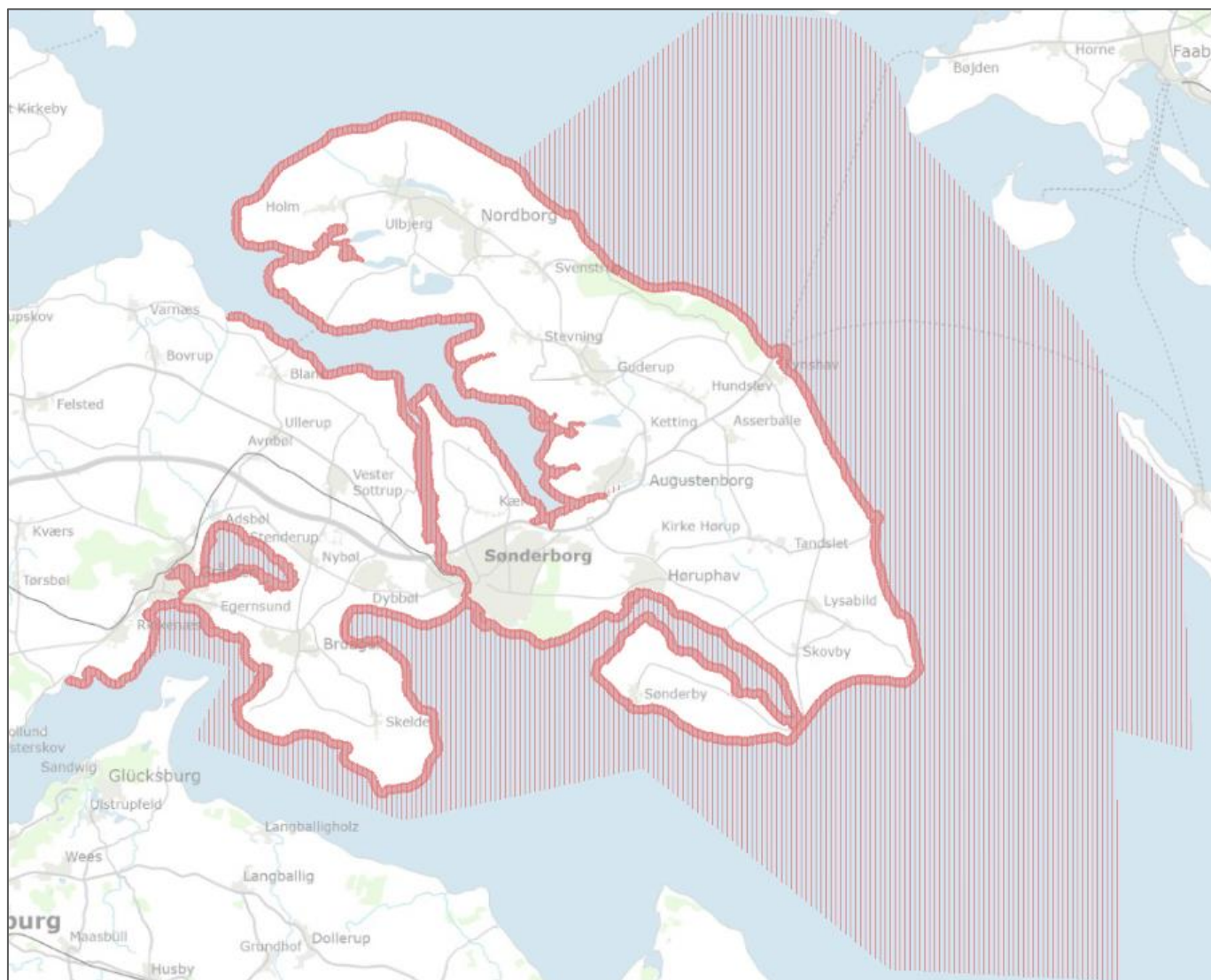


Personal Watercraft (PWC) Operation and board sailing Regulations in the Sønderborg area



Natura 2000 area is marked with red shading – PWC's and jet skis are **NOT** permitted to be driven here at any time!

For the 300 metre areas marked in dark red, the following applies to all forms of coastal navigation:

- Be aware of the bathing guests
- Show consideration for birds and other wildlife on and in the water
- Keep an eye out for other sailors and signal your course to others in good time
- Always keep a good distance from anchors
- Remember the life jacket
- Always sail perpendicular to and from shore at a **maximum of 5 knots** (9.26 km/h).
- Have fun - but always remember to **keep at least 300 metres from the coast.**

Natura 2000 is an ecological network of protected areas in the territory of the European Union, in order to protect the most seriously threatened habitats and species across Europe.

The driver of a personal watercraft, jet ski or electric board must be at least 16 years old, carry a personal watercraft licence and be covered by valid liability insurance. Violation is punishable by a fine
